Atlanta-based hip-hop illustrator Dubelyoo is known for his work with pencil and paint, but he's got an ass-load of projects in the works — both in and out of the art world.

"I'm a ninja, a masseuse and a professional checker player, but I'm not a DJ," admitted Dubelyoo — but he's preparing to release his own self-branded mix tape. DJ Jamad of Sirius Satellite Radio originally propositioned Dubelyoo to construct a mix for his show, but instead Dubelyoo enlisted the aid of Public Enemy's DJ Lord. The as-yet-untilled project, which will feature rare grooves, funk and soul tracks, will be broadcast on Sirius and made available on CD at various local retail outlets.

Sporting an artistic style that mixes classic illustration elements with urban sensibilities, Dubelyoo serves as one of the principals behind the traveling art show *Art, Beats & Lyrics*.

He originally gained local street cred by providing artwork for the *Afromentals* mix-tape series, but since those early days, he's provided illustrations for companies like Pepsi, Coca-Cola, Apple, Fubu and Scion.

Dubelyoo plans to debut his new line of T-shirts, dubbed *Savior Sol*, this August at the *Magic* fashion-retail show in Las Vegas. He describes the line as "Artsy shirts designed to be collectibles."

He advises aspiring artists to perfect the art of self-promotion. "Self-promotion is the key to survival for independent artists. And the more media coverage you get, the more media coverage you're gonna get." Maserati


Last week, Pitchfork Media, the popular and controversial online music magazine, posted an update on Athens indie-rock band **Maserati**. The brief story reported that the group has been without a label since Kindercore Records collapsed in 2004.

But that hasn't stopped Maserati from writing new songs for a follow-up to its critically acclaimed debut, *The Language of Cities*. "We're about two-thirds of the way done," says lead singer Coley Dennis during a phone interview. Maserati plans to record the album at local engineer Andy Baker's (Japancakes, Mercury Program) home studio in May. After that, the band will shop around the as-yet-untilled album to different indie labels. In the meantime, Athens imprint Hello Sir is reissuing the group's old material, which includes two EPs and a 7-inch single, as well as *The Language of Cities*, which has sold 5,000 copies to date, according to Dennis. Maserati's next show is March 11 at Caledonia Lounge in Athens, where Dennis works as a booking agent and bartender.

**Mastodon** recently filmed a video for "Seabeast," the third single from the ever-popular *Leviathan* album, at the Madison Theater in East Atlanta Village. The clip, which thematically (and metaphorically, I presume) takes a cue from Herman Melville's *Moby Dick*, is currently being submitted to various video channels for review and should make its worldwide premiere soon.


In CD release parties this week, the good folks at Decatur's **New Street Gallery and Recordings** are celebrating their *New Street Live* compilation with a party Fri., Feb. 3, at Eyedrum Art & Music Gallery. Several bands are slated to perform, including Hope for Agoldensummer, Inceptdate, Brian Montero, Jufu B Solomon, Siamese Self, and the Marsh. ... **The Roy Owens Jr.** celebrates *Good Times* with a concert Sat., Feb. 4, at Lenny's. Other acts on the bill include Pardner and the Bouldercrest Singing Group.
